Services available within Harris

Travel Services

Option 1:

The NHS have the Patient Transport Service. The hours they work are limited.

Patient Travel Service can be contacted via phone: 01851 708021

Option 2:

Harris Community Wheels. The wheelchair accessible vehicle based at Leverburgh Care Home is for community use. There are volunteer drivers available if the person using the vehicle doesn't drive. They don't charge for the service, but users can make a donation.

Exemptions of Council Tax

Extract from the Council Tax Leaflet 2025-26:

“Occupied Property Reductions

- *Some occupied properties may be exempt (for example, where all the occupants are aged under 18).*
- *A discount of 25% may be awarded if you are the sole adult resident (aged 18 or over) in the property.*
- *A reduction may be possible if a resident is disabled, and the property has certain features or facilities provided to meet their needs. The reduction takes the form of a drop in the valuation band (for example, from Band C to Band B).*
- *A Council Tax Reduction may be available if you are on a low income. The amount awarded will depend on your household income, capital, personal circumstances and the amount of Council Tax payable.*
- *Some discounts and reductions cannot be awarded on the water and sewerage element of your bill.”*

Exemptions and discounts can differ per accounts and are looked at case by case.

People who suffer from Dementia or Parkinson for example can be exempt from the Council Tax.
