- Catchment area required: Coverage from Bogha Glas (Bowglass) to Luskentyre only
 - More government support for school
 - Increase in staff
 - More space required
 - More variety in subjects and more opportunities for pupils
 - Unrestricted access to school for sport and freetime activities for the whole community.
